MAIN PLAYOFF SEEDING

Top two teams from each group advance. Group winners and runners-up are ranked separately by DSC (average LSD result). Quarterfinals: 1st #1–2nd #4; 1st #2–2nd #3; 1st #3–2nd #2; 1st #4–2nd #1.

WOMEN'S PLAYOFF SEEDING

Women's semifinals are played by the four highest-ranked women's teams that do not qualify for the main quarterfinals. Ranking is based first on final group position; if equal, DSC decides. Semifinals: W#1–W#4 and W#2–W#3.

RULES – ALL GAMES

LSD / hammer & colour: Before each game, one LSD is played. The order of the LSD throw is drawn before the game. The winner of the LSD chooses either last-stone advantage (hammer) or stone colour.
Round-robin format: Games are played over 8 ends with a time limit. If the score is tied after 8 ends, one extra end is played.

Playoff choice: In playoff games, the team with the better final group position has the right to choose either last-stone advantage (hammer) or stone colour. If both teams finished in the same position, DSC decides.
Playoff format: Playoff games are played over 8 ends without a time limit.
